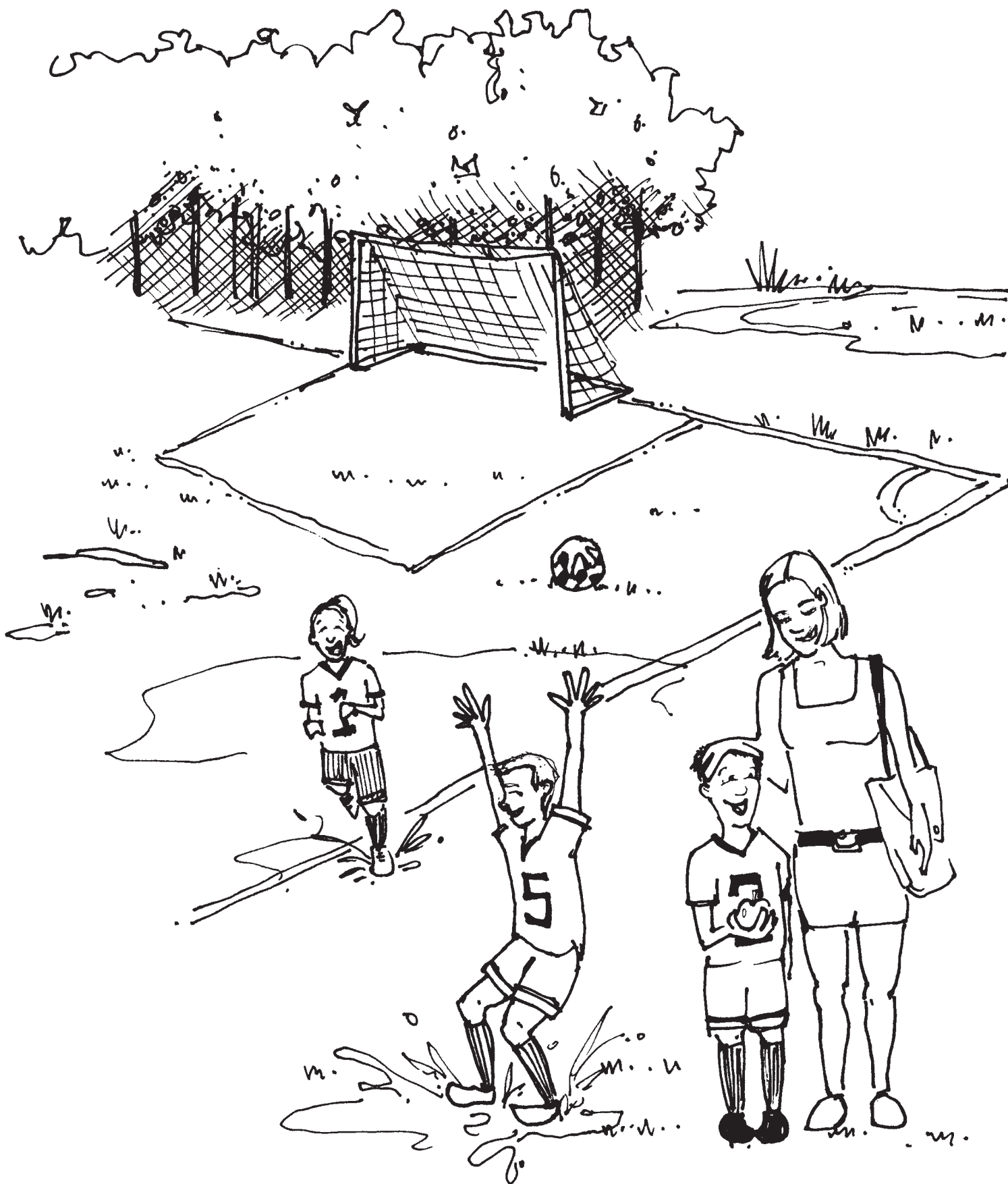

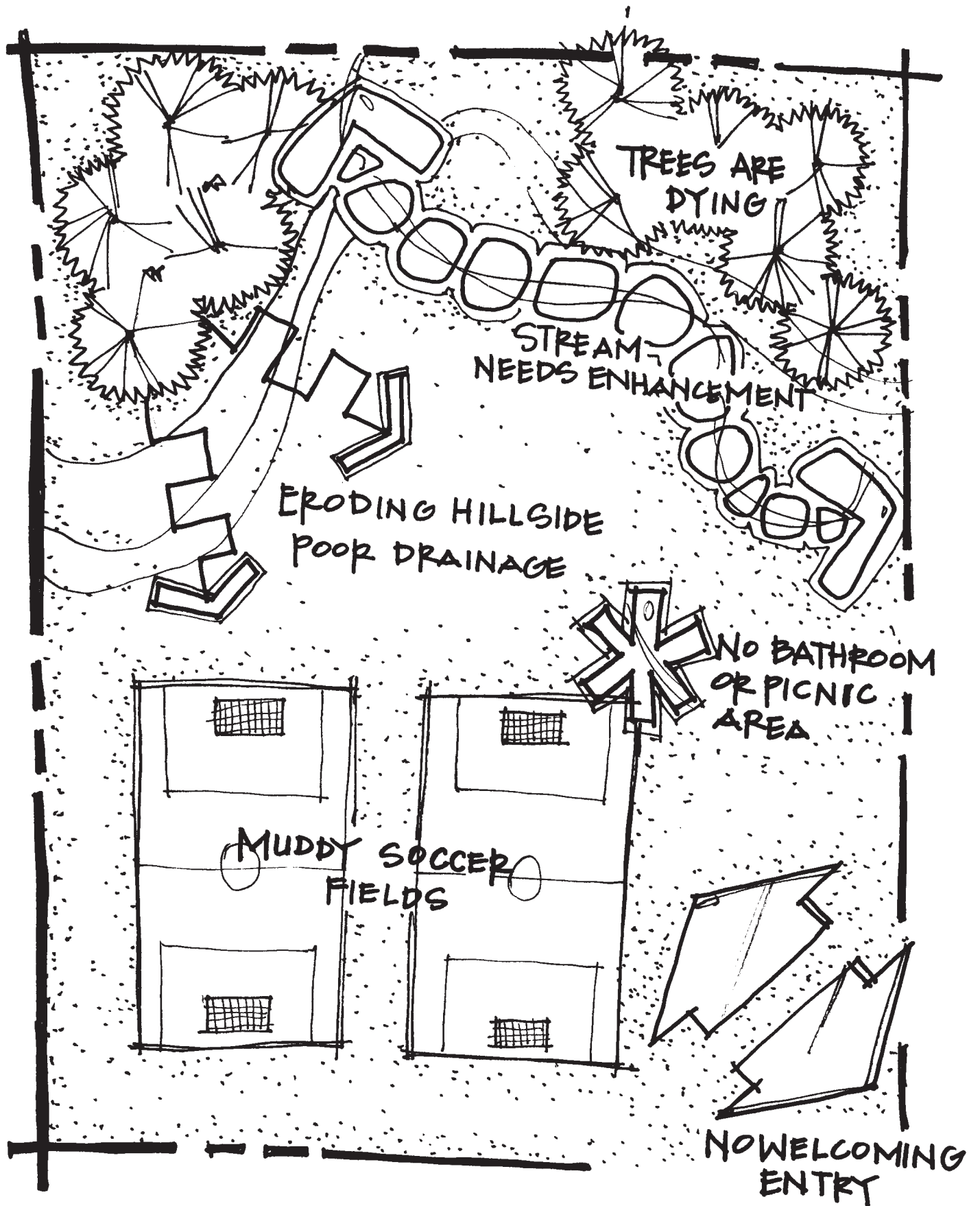




"Johnny's dad is a Landscape Architect, so we asked him to help us with a new design for the park."

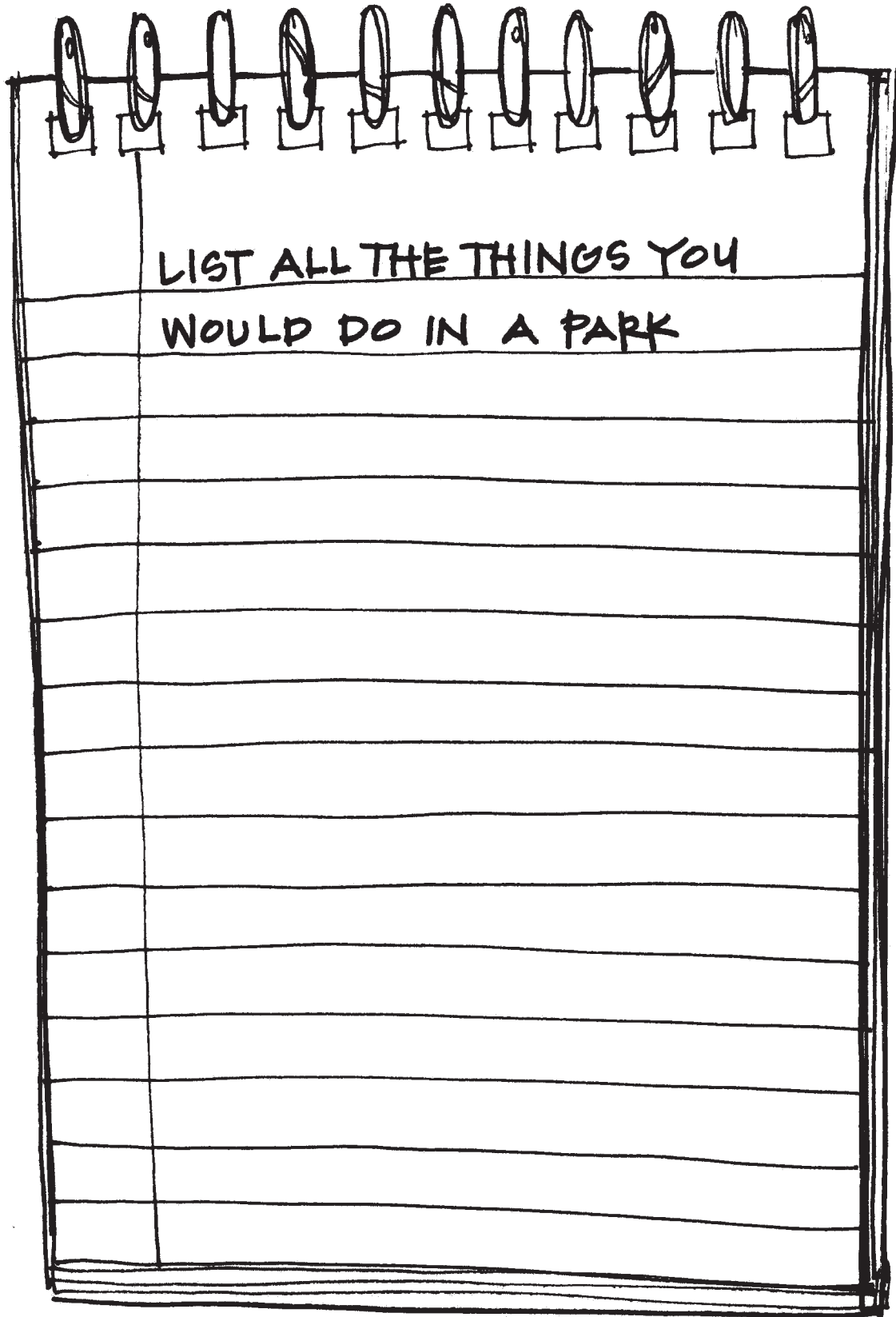
The first thing that the Landscape Architect did was to visit the park and identify everything that was wrong.

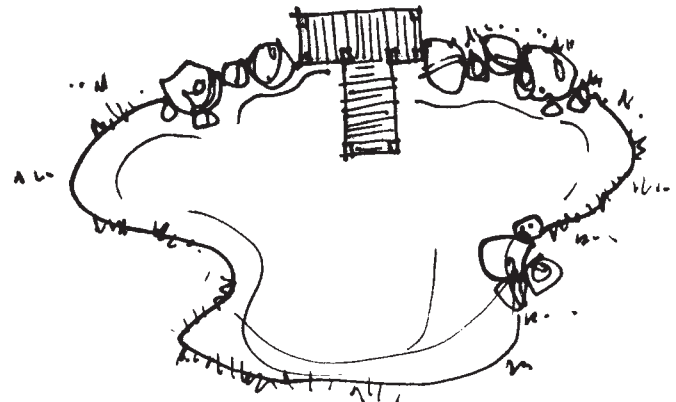
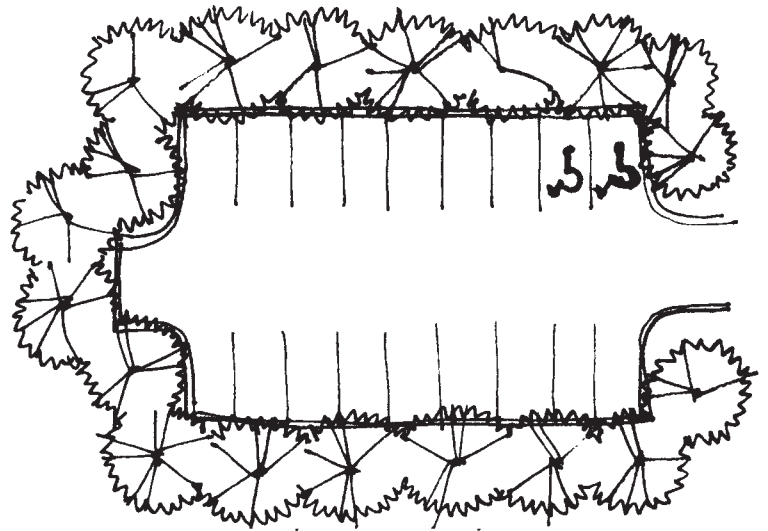
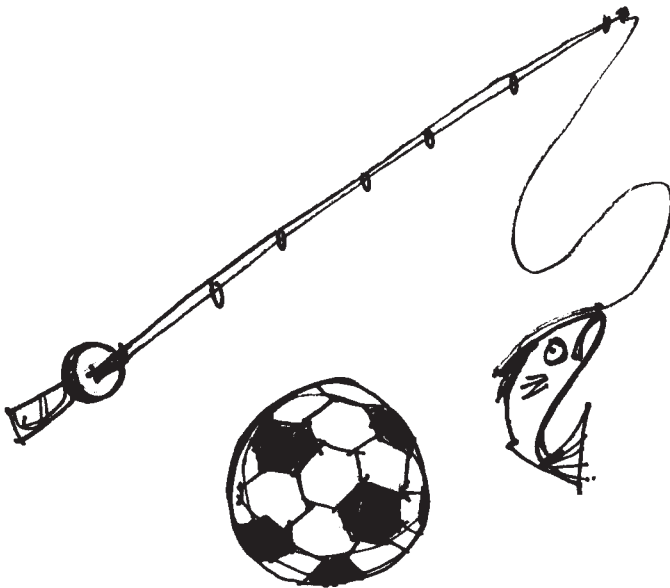
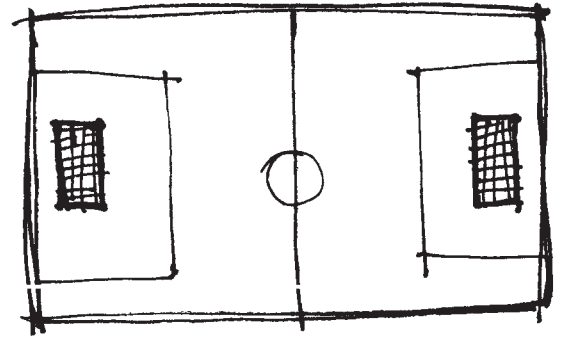
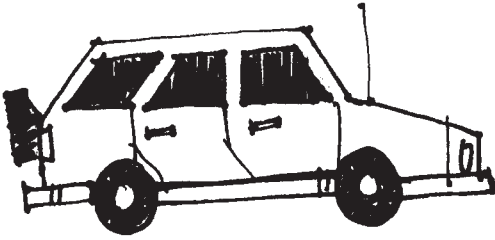




The Landscape Architect prepared a site analysis.

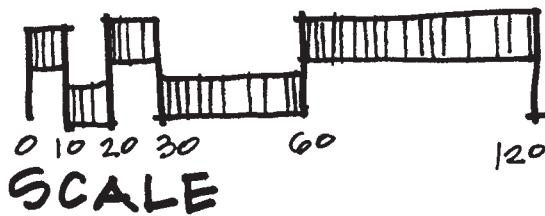
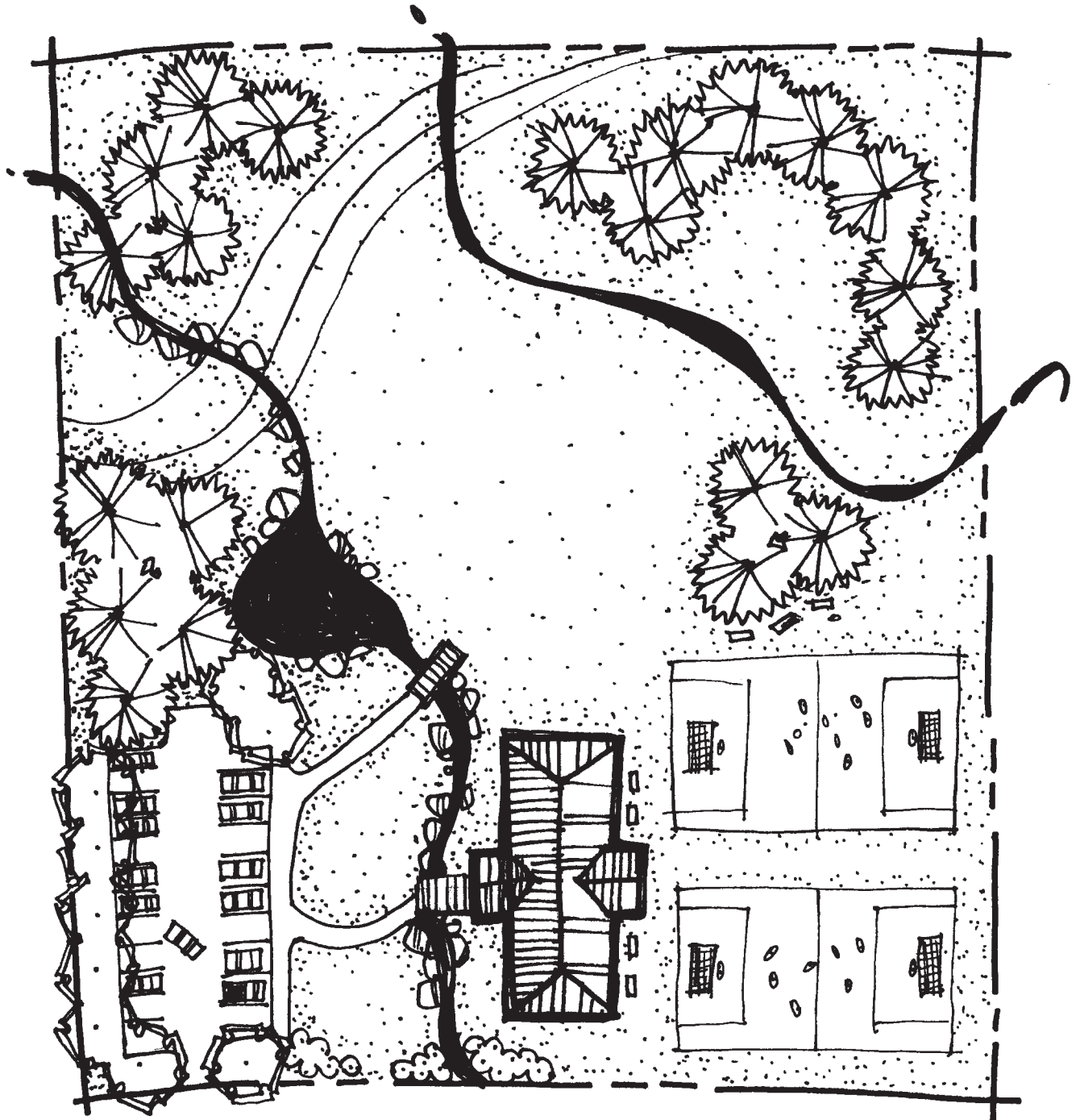
Then the Landscape Architect met with all of the people who use the park and asked them what the new park needed.
